

# All you need to know about Takeover Day

## For museums and heritage organisations

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Are you a museum, gallery, historic house, archive, heritage or cultural venue looking to provide meaningful experiences for children and young people in your organisation? Would you like to be involved with a long-running high profile national initiative? Then Takeover Day is for you.

### What is Takeover Day?

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Takeover Day is when heritage and cultural sites invite children and young people to take over jobs normally done by adults. Over 5,000 people, from toddlers to 25 year olds, now take part each year.

Children and young people take over both front of house roles, such as welcome hosts or tour guides, and behind-the-scenes roles, such as press officers or curators. They co-create events and exhibitions, give their feedback on venues' offers for young people and help to design new activities or facilities.

### Why take part?

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You can:

- give young people new opportunities to be part of your organisation
- pilot new ways of working
- find new partners in your local community
- experience a fresh perspective on your venue
- enthuse staff across your organisation
- build your profile through social media and press coverage.
